#### SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR 2023-24

#### PRIMARY SCHOOL SUPPLIES:

If your child will be in Kindergarten, Grades 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5 in September 2023 we will be purchasing primary school supplies in bulk at a discounted price. We will provide your child with all school supplies needed for the year at a set cost of \$30 per child. This does not include the price of the planner. This serves many purposes and benefits:

- Equitable access and a continued supply of resources for your child. This includes loss and damage of items.
- Supplies that are customized for the individual classroom and needs.
- Prices that are not available at a standard retail price but instead are purchased through corporate discounts and in bulk. These savings help our families.
- With the exception of a few supplies that will go home, all supplies will be considered consumables
- · Aligns with eco-friendly and sustainable initiatives

#### INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL SUPPLIES:

General school supplies lists for intermediate students will be available soon. Class specific school supplies lists will be available when your child gets his/her new teacher in September. Please note there will be a separate charge for your child's portfolio binder and planner.
